A motion that the Board of Trustees approve a proposal from Waldners Furniture for the purchase of office furniture, delivery & set-up in the amount of \$14,647.94 (state-contract pricing) was made by Mayor Parente, seconded by Trustee Lark. **The motion was passed unanimously.** (ARPA funds will be used to fund this expenditure)

A motion that the Board of Trustees approve a proposal from Milburn Flooring for the purchase, delivery & installation of carpet for the Village Office in the amount of \$2,919.78 (state-contracting pricing) was made by Mayor Parente, seconded by Trustee Lark. **The motion was passed unanimously.** (ARPA funds will be used to fund this expenditure)

The Village Clerk advised the Board that there were still approximately 100 water bills that remained unpaid. The Board instructed the staff to send one delinquent water bill notice. She also advised the Board that the catch basin on Donald Street has been pumped out and cleaned while we still wait for the County DPW to decide if we can connect this catch basin to the County's drainage system.

The Mayor advised the Board that Pauline Preis has stepped up to run the Easter Egg Hunt again this year.

Pat Theodore, in his capacity as Village Code Enforcement Officer, advised the Board to some mischief that occurred on Saturday night and was reported to the Nassau County Police Department. The incidents involved individuals in ski masks and gloves banging and kicking on resident's doors on Atlanta Avenue.
