REGULAR MEETING
MONDAY, DECEMBER 13, 2021

Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Village of East Williston was held on Monday, December 13, 2021 at 7:30 pm at the Village Hall, 2 Prospect Street, East Williston, New York.

There were present: Mayor Bonnie L.S. Parente, Trustees Raffaella Dunne, James Iannone, James Lark, Anthony Gallo, Village Clerk Marie Hausner, Village Attorney Jeffrey Blinkoff.

On the motion of Trustee Lark , seconded by Trustee Gallo, and with Mayor Parente, Trustees Dunne, Iannone, Lark and Gallo all voting “aye”, the Board approved the minutes of the regular meeting of November 8, 2021.

On the motion of Trustee Iannone, seconded by Trustee Dunne , and with Mayor Parente and Trustees Dunne, Iannone, Lark and Gallo all voting “aye”, the Board approved the minutes of the agenda meeting of November 29, 2021.

On the motion of Mayor Parente , seconded by Trustee Gallo , and with Trustees Dunne, Iannone Lark and Gallo all voting “aye”, the Board unanimously approved the abstract of claims for November 2021 (20210261 - 20210315).

TRUSTEE REPORTS

MAYOR BONNIE L.S. PARENTE

Mayor Parente thanked Tzu Chi Organization for the fantastic performance of the Tzu Chi Youth Orchestra on December 4th. It was her hope that they will return for future performances in the community.

The Mayor also stated had conversations with members of Tzu Chi that day about the organization participating in other community events.

DEPUTY MAYOR/TRUSTEE RAFFAELA DUNNE

Trustee Dunne reported that 125 residents participated in the Thanksgiving Drumstick Dash which benefited the East Williston Fire Department.

Twenty five families participated in the holiday photo op with the antique fire truck and Santa. This event benefited payment of insurance for the antique fire truck.

TRUSTEE JAMES IANNONE

The Village Justice Court for November 2021 reported one parking violation, six moving violations and no village ordinance violations. \$945.00 total fines collected with \$168.00 in New York State surcharges.

TRUSTEE JAMES LARK

Trustee Lark stated that the East Williston Little League was presented with proclamations last month for the district championship win in the Williamsport Little League World Series.

The Little League is now getting ready for spring registration.

Trustee Lark had no public work or Beautification Committee report to present.

TRUSTEE ANTHONY GALLO

Trustee Gallo presented the East Williston Fire Department for November 2021. The department responded to a total of 14 calls. Three emergency (EMS) calls, three general alarms, and eight mutual aid calls to neighboring departments.

The police report from the Nassau County Police Department Third Precinct for October 2021 noted no auto accidents, one aided case, no reports of burglary, robbery, larceny auto or criminal mischief. No moving or parking violations were issued.
