Mayor Parente called the meeting to order at 7:07 p.m. and verified the presence of a quorum.

General topics discussed in the public session included:

- Hydrant flushing commenced Sunday April 16th – more communication to the residents next time. Mail notification, put banner on website, email & include in monthly flyers
- Add a flyer to the next mailings for residents to sign up and verify they are getting the village emails.
- Village wide tree replacement planting has commenced.
- Request quotes for the village road repaving capital plan to include the top 7 streets that have been identified by Department of Public Works as the most in need of repaving.
- New ticket book for code enforcement officer.
- Village clerk is working on obtaining estimates to paint and repair trim work to Village Hall & the Fire Department.
- Public hearing at next BOT meeting regarding village fine schedule.

Mayor Parente made a motion which was seconded by Trustee Dunne in support of the Anthony Leva Memorial Dog Run at the Roslyn Road Park. **The motion was passed unanimously.**

Mayor Parente made a motion which was seconded by Trustee Dunne that the Board hereby determines that it is the lead agency under the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act (“SEQRA”), and that the determinations with respect to the Anthony Leva Memorial Dog Run are further found by the Board to have no significant effect or impact under SEQRA. **The motion was passed unanimously.**

Mayor Parente made a motion which was seconded by Trustee Gallo that a public hearing to consider a local law amending section 1-18 of the Village Code with respect the imposition of fines for the violation of Village ordinances in order to provide that the penalty to be imposed upon a finding of guilty for a violation of a Village ordinance shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding \$5,000 shall be held before the Board of Trustees at its meeting on June 12, 2023. **The motion was passed unanimously**

Mayor Parente made a motion which was seconded by Trustee Iannone to go into executive session at 8:15pm to discuss personnel matters. At 8:22pm Trustee Dunne made a motion to return to the public session. The motion was seconded by Trustee Iannone.

Trustee Dunne made a motion which was seconded by Trustee Dunne to adjourn the meeting at 8:23. **The motion was passed unanimously**
