AGENDA MEETING
TUESDAY, MAY 31, 2022

Agenda meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Village of East Williston was held on Tuesday, May 31, 2022 at 7:30 pm at the Village Hall, 2 Prospect Street, East Williston, New York.

There were present: Mayor Bonnie L.S. Parente, Trustees Raffaella Dunne, James Iannone, James Lark Anthony Gallo, Village Clerk Marie Hausner, Treasurer Michael Delury, Deputy Clerk William Basel, Secretary to the Board of Trustees Bonnie Kreisman, Village Attorney Jeffrey L. Blinkoff.

It was suggested to send an email blast to remind residents that dumping of pool water in the street is against both NYS and Village code – as per the NYS Storm Water Relief Act.

The ceremony to light the tree on the Village green in gold will be held on August 31st in support of pediatric cancer awareness.

The Village car show went well.

Trustee Gallo was asked to obtain an updated status of the selling of the old fire truck and the radio room construction.

Trustee Gallo was excused at 8:10pm for personal reasons.

The Board entered into executive session at 8:10pm on a motion by Mayor Parente, seconded by Deputy Mayor Dunne and exited executive session at 8:28pm. No action was taken.

The Springbrook financial system conversion process was escalated to top priority and an implementation schedule was requested.

The Village Hall hardwood floors will be refinished over the July 4th weekend. Work to be performed by Ampport.

Mark Davella, through Bonnie Kreisman, advised that the 2022-23 SCARs might reflect high reductions that normal due to the major fluctuations in home values/sales.
