**AGENDA MEETING**  
**MONDAY, AUGUST 30, 2021**

Agenda meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Village of East Williston was held on Monday, August 30, 2021 at 7:30 pm at the Village Hall, 2 Prospect Street, East Williston, New York.

There were present: Mayor Bonnie L.S. Parente, Trustees Raffaella Dunne, James Iannone, Anthony Gallo, Marie L. Hausner, Village Clerk, Deputy Clerk William Basel, Secretary to the Board of Trustees Bonnie Kreisman, Village Attorney Jeffrey L. Blinkoff.

Excused from meeting: Trustee James Lark, Treasurer Michael Delury.

Mayor Parente noted the following items for discussion/follow up:

- On September 11<sup>th</sup>, the village will be commemorating the 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary of 9/11 with a candle light ceremony on the village green at 7pm.
- Trustee Lark is still working on the equipment replacement for the sprinklers at Devlin Field.
- It was hoped to have a band give a concert on the village green next June without an RSVP. Residents would just bring their chairs or blankets and listen to the music.
- When the village office receives the date for the repair of lights on Feather Lane, the residents who reported the outages should be emailed when this will take place.
- The village did not receive any response from the help wanted ad for part time code enforcer. Ms. Kreisman advised she will speak with Kerry Collins to see if he knows of anyone who may want the position.
- The temporary speed bumps have arrived. A question arose whether they needed to be removed in the winter to enable snow plowing.
- A follow up with Simon Blanco of the department of public works for the planting of trees in the fall. It was believed there were 15 requests for trees to be planted.
- New public works employee Domingos DaSilva was commended for his attention to storm readiness before Hurricane Henri entered the north east.
- Jared Mandel still needs to provide a design for the conference room renovation, to be able to apply for the grant from Legislator Nicoletto's office.
- Ask Simon Blanco or the other public works employees if they wish to attend the NYCOM Public Works conference in Saratoga Springs in October. Mr. Basel was also invited to attend.
- The proclamations for the East Williston Little League will be presented at the November 8, 2021 meeting.

Trustee Dunne stated that the punch list items for the tennis courts will be addressed in September. The company will need three days of closure to the courts for the final coats of texture to cure and set.

Mr. Basel stated that he is awaiting the invoice from Orchid Water & Sewer to forward to National Grid for the water main break that took place on Roslyn Road, near Fairview Avenue.

Ms. Kreisman stated that half of the remaining meters from Bader Meter should be received by the first week in September. The rest will follow in late September.

The City Grows contract has been reviewed by Mr. Blinkoff and should be forwarded to the village for signature.

Ms. Kreisman stated that Mark Davella wanted to meet with the Board regarding the challenge by Maidenbaum of various municipalities RAR.

Mayor Parente asked that he come to the September agenda meeting on September 27, 2021
