

The East Williston Beautification Committee is comprised of volunteer residents who plan projects for our village. No gardening experience is required. Community service students and scout groups are welcome. Volunteers are responsible for planting, maintaining and decorating areas as outlined below:

January – Holiday decorations (village hall interior) packed up by the weekend following New Year's Day.

February thru April – No activity scheduled. DPW begins spring cleanup.

May - Walking meeting scheduled between BC, DPW and board liaison to outline work for upcoming Memorial Day ceremony (village hall and RR planters, village green memorial area). DPW will advise when planting areas have been prepared and ready.

June thru September – Additional planting ongoing. BC to provide proposal for other project(s) they would like to undertake during this time. Walking meeting, if necessary, will be scheduled. Board will review/approve. If DPW assistance is required, a work order will have to be filed with the village office. DPW scheduled work will take precedence.

September/October - Fall decorations (VH and RR planters). Cornstalks attached to lamp posts along historic district of EW Avenue.

November – Holiday decorations (VH interior, exterior VH and RR planters). This is done on the Saturday following Thanksgiving.

December – No activity scheduled
