

VILLAGE OF EAST WILLISTON
LOCAL LAW _____ OF 2023 AMENDING CHAPTER 109 ENTITLED “PUBLIC CONDUCT”
TO ADD NEW SECTIONS 109-19, 20 AND 21

Section 1. Amending the Village Code to add new sections 109-19, 20 and 21 to read as follows:

§ 109-19. Cannabis restrictions.

In addition to all other restrictions imposed by law, rule or regulation, the smoking, ingesting or vaping of cannabis is prohibited in all public spaces within the Village. Public spaces shall include, but not be limited to, all public rights-of-way.

§ 109-20. Urinating in public.

A person is guilty of public urination if, in a public place, he or she shall urinate other than in a urinal or toilet.

§ 109-21. Disorderly conduct.

A person is guilty of disorderly conduct when, with intent to cause public inconvenience, annoyance or alarm, or recklessly creating a risk thereof the person:

1. *Engages in fighting or in violent, tumultuous or threatening behavior; or*
2. *Makes unreasonable noise; or*
3. *In a public place, uses abusive or obscene language, or makes an obscene gesture; or*
4. *Without lawful authority, disturbs any lawful assembly or meeting of persons; or*
5. *Obstructs vehicular or pedestrian traffic; or*
6. *Congregates with other persons in a public place and refuses to comply with a lawful order of the police to disperse; or*
7. *Creates a hazardous or physically offensive condition by any act which serves no legitimate purpose.*

Section 2. Authority. The proposed local law is enacted pursuant to Municipal Home Rule Law §§10(1)(i), 10(1)(ii)(a)(1), 10(1)(ii)(a)(3), and 10(1)(ii)(a)(11).

Section 3. Severability. If any section or subsection, paragraph, clause, phrase, or provision of this law shall be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, any judgment made thereby shall not affect the validity of this law as a whole, or any part thereof other than the part or provision so adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 4. Effective Date. This local law shall take effect upon filing with the Secretary of State pursuant to Municipal Home Rule Law.
